- Complete Merit Badge Counselor training and attach certificate. <u>Merit Badge Counselor Training Boy Scouts of America</u>, Northern New Jersey Council (nnjbsa.org)
- Complete BSA Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion training (SCO-1800) and attach your certificate.
